The Bolton Summer Camp Leader in Training (LIT) program is designed for those ages 13 - 15. A LIT's major role at camp is to be actively involved in all camp activities, working with staff and acting as an enthusiastic responsible role model for our campers. LIT's must apply for this role at our camp as well as participate in a preseason interview.

Not all applicants are guaranteed a position; there are limited openings each week.

This program was not designed for those who are interested in simply hanging out with their friends for the summer. The purpose of this program is to learn general job skills as well as specific job requirements of counselors. All LIT's are expected to arrive to camp and act as if they were working at a job. Limited spaces each week.

If you are interested in becoming a LIT complete the application and return to the Bolton Recreation Department. Applications will be reviewed on a first come first serve basis. You will be notified via phone to schedule your

preseason Interview/trainings.
