The Bolton Summer Camp Leader in Training (LIT) program is designed for those ages 13 - 15. A LIT's major role at camp is to be actively involved in all camp activities, working with staff and acting as an enthusiastic responsible role model for our campers. LIT's must apply for this role at our camp as well as participate in a preseason interview. All applicants are not guaranteed a position; there are limited openings each week.

LIT General Role at Camp

Purpose: To work closely with camp staff, learning skills, responsibilities and qualities of a successful Group Leader

Time Required: A minimum of one camp session (one full week daily 9:30AM – 3:30PM during that full week), and attendance at a training session prior to the start of the program is also required.

Responsibilities:

- Assist counselors in support roles with campers
- Assist campers to know what is expected of them, camp rules and activity schedules.
- Insure that each camper participates in the planned activities
- Assist in preparing materials and supplies for camp activities
- Participate fully in all camper and counselor activities
- Serve as a positive role model
- Work as an active team member with the entire camp staff
- Cooperate with the camp director and camp staff
- Once a session come up with an activity that goes with the weekly theme and lead with a group of campers with the assistance of the group counselor.

Qualifications:

- Minimum of 13 years of age
- Displays positive attitude
- Demonstrates potential good-decision making and leadership skills
- Willingness to learn new things and contribute ideas
- Eager to accept new responsibilities and follow through
- Willingness to work as a team member

NO LATE APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED. This program was not designed for those who are interested in simply hanging out with their friends for the summer. The purpose of this program is to learn general job skills as well as specific job requirements of counselors. All LIT's are expected to arrive to camp and act as if they were working at a job. This program is to help those 13 -15 years of age prepare for working. Limited spaces each week.

Cost: \$100.00/week (additional costs may apply for field trips)
