LEADER IN TRAINING 2025

The Bolton Summer Camp Leader in Training (LIT) program is designed for those ages 14 - 15. A LIT's major role at camp is to be actively involved in all camp activities, working with staff and acting as an enthusiastic responsible role model for our campers. LIT's must apply for this role at our camp as well as participate in a preseason interview. Not all applicants are guaranteed a position; there are limited openings each week.

LIT General Role at Camp

Purpose: To work closely with camp staff, learning skills, responsibilities and qualities of a successful Group Leader

Time Required: A minimum of one camp session (one full week daily 9:30AM – 3:30PM during that full week)

Responsibilities:

- Assists counselors in support roles with campers
- Assists campers to know what is expected of them, camp rules and activity schedules.
- Ensures that each camper participates in the planned activities
- Assists in preparing materials and supplies for camp activities
- Participates fully in all camper and counselor activities
- Serves as a positive role model
- Works as an active team member with the entire camp staff
- Cooperates with the camp director and camp staff
- Once a session comes up with an activity that goes with the weekly theme and leads with a group of campers with the assistance of the group counselor.

Qualifications:

- Minimum of 14 years of age
- Displays positive attitude
- Demonstrates good decision making and leadership skills
- Willingness to learn new things and contribute ideas
- Eager to accept new responsibilities and follow through
- Willingness to work as a team member

This program was not designed for those who are interested in simply hanging out with their friends for the summer. The purpose of this program is to learn general job skills as well as specific job requirements of counselors. All LIT's are expected to arrive to camp and act as if they were working at a job. LIT's will join the camp on any scheduled field trips, however they will be expected to assist staff, not join campers on the field trip activities.

This program is to help those 14 -15 years of age prepare for work. Limited spaces each week.

Cost: \$50.00/week (additional costs may apply for field trips)
