All Ages are welcome and separated into three different sections of the field to hunt for eggs.

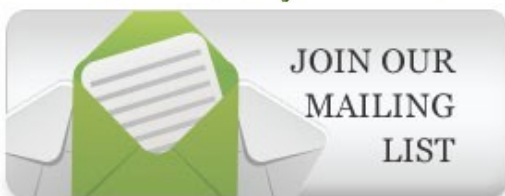
Ages 4 and under, Ages 5-7, Ages 8+

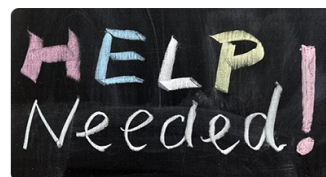
Recreation -Camp Counselor (Seasonal)
