The Bolton Summer Camp Leader in Training (LIT) program is designed for those ages 13 - 15 to prepare them for future jobs. A LIT's major role at camp is to be actively involved in all camp activities, working with staff and acting as an enthusiastic responsible role model for our campers.

This program was not designed for those who are interested in simply hanging out with their friends for the summer. The purpose of this program is to learn general job skills as well as specific job requirements of counselors. All LIT's are expected to arrive to camp and act as if they were working at a job.

Cost: \$100.00/week (additional costs may apply for field trips)

LIT's must apply for this role at our camp as well as participate in a preseason interview. All applicants are not guaranteed a position; there are limited openings each week.

All Leader in Training applications are due no later than May 30, 2022.
